CHARTER SCHOOL POLICIES & GUIDELINES:

ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE & ADMIN FEES: The \$40 annual registration fee pays secondary insurance for your child to be out on our floor during class time and open workout for 1 year. Our goal is to provide the best we can for your child and we feel our choice of insurance companies reflects this. This fee is non-refundable and will be charged annually. This fee **MUST** be paid before your child is able to attend an enrolled class. If your charter school is paying this fee, we must receive a PO stating the \$40 is added to the regular class fees. No exceptions. In addition to our annual registration fee, an administration fee of \$10 per family will be added to the cost of the classes for each session.

PURCHASE ORDERS (PO) CLASSES: Purchase orders must be received and approved before you are able to enroll your child into a class. POs may be submitted at our front office or be emailed to our designated homeschool email: homeschool@Charteroakgym.com. It is the parent's responsibility to make sure Charter Oak Gymnastics has an accurate PO at all times. Purchase orders must be presented with the full amount for each session at the time of enrollment. Half payments are not accepted. Purchase orders may not exceed an 8 week period (Fall, Winter, Spring) or a 5 week period (Summer) and will follow our session schedule. If a PO is not for the full amount of the session, the parent is responsible for the remaining balance at the time of enrollment. Once we've received your PO, you will be able to enroll your child during the proper enrollment periods. A new PO must be submitted for each session and must have the correct dates indicated on the form.

*Please see below for the correct prices and enrollment periods.

PURCHASE ORDERS (PO) CAMPS/CLINICS: POs may be used for our Winter/Summer Weekly Day Camps and for some of our Clinics (please see office for more information). If you will be using a PO for a Camp/Clinic, the PO must be presented at the time of enrollment and must be for the full amount to enroll your child.

PAYMENTS/CREDITS/REFUNDS: Pro-rations will only be made if Charter Oak Gymnastics is closed or if your child starts classes after the session has started. In these cases, if the PO is made out for the full amount, we will *only* bill your Charter School for the pro-rated amount, we will never over bill. Due to the nature of this program, refunds will not be given (Please refer to our General Policies and Guidelines regarding and further information about our Credit Policies). If your Charter School is unable to pay a PO for any reason, Charter Oak Gymnastics will contact the parent directly for payment. It is not our intention to create a financial hardship for any of our customers. If the due date of the payment is not convenient for you, please contact the front desk and an alternative arrangement can be made.

CLASSES: Charter Oak Gymnastics wants your child to have a safe, fun and educational experience while you are with us. In order to accomplish this, we have to be able to regulate class size. If you find that you are going to have to drop classes either permanently or temporarily, you must notify the front desk in advance. Failure to do so will result in you being responsible for tuition until we are notified that your child is dropping class. Keeping up-to-date records is difficult without knowing what your intentions are. Help us help you by maintaining class size integrity.

EXTENDED ABSENCE: If you are unable to attend class for 2 weeks or more due to a medical problem, we will pro-rate that session's tuition for you. (Doctor's note is required- This is for the safety of your child!) Let us know prior to returning to class in order for us to do so. Please be sure to keep us informed if your child will be missing one or more classes.
